What is the CEMA Business Barometer?

- A monthly survey within the European agricultural machinery industry (started in 2008)
- ► Coverage of all major sectors from tractors to municipal equipment
- ► Target group: 140 senior managers from 9 (CEMA) countries
- Implementation: online survey
- Questionnaire available in five languages
- Executed by VDMA for CEMA
- Subjects of the survey:
 - current and future business situation
 - situation of order intake
 - development of turnover
 - turnover expectation per country
 - production plans
 - employment plans
 - special topics, e.g. delivery times
- ▶ Deadlines: starting ca. 5th each month, closure: ca. 13th





Current business evaluation on highest level since 2011

Executive summary of the survey in January

The general business climate index of the agricultural machinery industry in Europe keeps with only little changes on a very good level. The evaluation of the current business has further improved (reached its highest value since 2011), while the future expectations are no longer as high as in the last months.

In terms of breakdown by segment, business climate for tractors remains below the industry average (both, future and current business evaluation). For the arable equipment segment, order intake expectations have slipped below the total industry average, which may signal that the upswing is going to slow down. On the other hand, manufacturers of livestock equipment still appear to be not worried about prospects of lower milk prices.

The regional breakdown shows once again for each single European market a majority of survey participants expecting turnover increases. This month, the Netherlands has become one of the top-rated markets (after Germany and the UK). Poland is no longer rated as euphoric as last month, but remains on high level. The Scandinavian, and even more the CIS countries, have already reached the top of the upswing. At the bottom of the country ranking ends up again Spain.



CEMA Business Climate Index (CBI) -Total






